



TAKE OUR CHILDREN TO WORK DAY MASSACHUSETTS APRIL 30, 2019

Every April, [Tuesday's Children](#) holds an annual *Take Our Children to Work Day*, in partnership with a diverse group of top organizations. Once again, we are proud to announce a collaboration with [Massachusetts Military Heroes Fund \(MMHF\)](#) and [Massachusetts Soldiers Legacy Fund \(MSLF\)](#) to bring this program to Massachusetts on **Tuesday, April 30, 2019**.

Tuesday's Children's Take Our Children to Work Day is a one-day mentoring program modeled after the national campaign designed to provide children with a valuable, educational workplace experience. Tuesday's Children's program is unique, bringing together children and parents bereaved by terrorism (either on 9/11 or through a family member's post 9/11 military service) for a day of learning and reflection.

We are excited to announce that for a fourth year, Take Our Children to Work Day will be available in Massachusetts through our partner organizations which support bereaved military children. Parents interested in enrolling their children in this valuable opportunity are asked to complete the [registration form](#) no later than **Friday, March 22, 2019**.

Massachusetts Take Our Children to Work Day at the State House. Children interested in public service, legislation and politics are invited to the [State House](#), where they will:

- Meet different members of the Governor's office, House of Representatives and Senate
- Enjoy a private tour and luncheon
- Complete a legacy activity honoring their military or 9/11 family member
- Visit offices of Massachusetts legislators and learn about careers in public service
